– New bullet weight and product line extension with new calibers

Fürth, Germany. In the past few years, RWS EVO GREEN has become established as the clever lead-free alternative in a broad caliber range. The modern, highly effective bullet is an evolution of the proven H-jacket technology. For even better performance, the weight of the RWS EVO GREEN has been adjusted from 8.8 g to 9.0 g in the .30 calibers. In addition, RWS is now offering the bullet in the ever more popular 6.5 Creedmoor caliber as well.

For everyone who wants to stay away from traditional hunting ammunition containing lead, RWS has been offering an extremely clever alternative for a few years now with its bullet development, the EVOLUTION GREEN. The sophisticated and fine-tuned special features in the design guarantees accurate and successful hunting. The bullet cores are made of food-safe tin. The RWS EVOLUTION GREEN achieves its convincing bullet effect through special pre-fragmentation of the front bullet core and the use of the new RSW Speed-Tip bullet tip – especially at long shooting distances. Naturally, the

EVOLUTION GREEN has the normal product advantages of an RWS rifle shell: reliable, effective, precise, gentle on the barrel, and innovative.

Driven by innovations, RWS has pledged to continuously improve its products. That is why the shot weight in calibers .308 Win., .30–06, .30R Blaser and .300 Win. Mag. is being increased from the original 8.8 g to 9.0 g. In addition, the percentage of disintegration of the pre-fragmented tin core in front is reduced.

This offers the following practical advantage: Higher depth effect with less damage to the game meat. Also available is the EVO GREEN in 6.5 Creedmore caliber and in the short rifle line in the calibers .308 Win. and .30-06. You can find more information in the press release on the line expansion of the RWS short rifle range.

The benefits at a glance:

- **The effect bonus:** Excellent responsive behavior by repeatedly perforating the front tine core and through the Speed-Tip bullet tip for a convincing effect in the moment. The results are shorter flight distances and less looking.
- **The distance bonus:** Convincing killing effect even at high shooting distances. With conventional designs, deformation readiness goes way down at great distances. Not so with EVO GREEN! Thanks to the intelligent bullet design, this effect is greatly reduced.
- **High-velocity ballistics:** A flat trajectory at a high velocity and with high energy due to the optimized bullet form (high BC) with a Speed-Tip bullet tip.
- **Reliable stalking signs:** Guaranteed exit wound due to a dimensionally stable rear body, ensuring a blood trail. The sharp edge provides the desired hair at the location of impact.
